Let's look at the typical characteristics of a Poor Listener vs. Good Listener

- Always interrupts
- Jumps to conclusions
- Changes the subject
- Finishes other people's sentences
- Gives no response
- Is inattentive, has wandering eyes, and poor posture

- Asks questions to clarify what is said
- Does not rush the speaker
- Does not interrupt
- Keeps on the subject until the speaker finishes their thought
- Responds with head nodding, a smile, or frown
