Carriers wrote more than \$2.65 billion in total new annualized premium sales in the first half of 2025, a 7% decrease over the same period of 2024.






Disability Insurance

Carriers wrote \$2.3 billion in total new annualized premium sales in the first half of 2025, a 7% decrease from the same period last year.

Workplace Disability Insurance Sales




Supplemental Health Insurance

In the first half of 2025, carriers reported over \$1.9 billion in new annualized premium for supplemental health insurance products. This represented a 5% decrease when compared to the same period last year.
