Authorization for use of the CEP

A new CEP Customer Portal will replace the current online progress look-up.

Step 1) Please identify your company's Main Contact. The Main Contact should be able to provide LIMRA with current and future CEP Customer Portal Authorized Users. The Main Contact may also receive information from LIMRA about the CEP Customer Portal and should be able to distribute it appropriately throughout your company.

An Authorized User will have the ability to access the CEP Customer Portal to search student activity and transcripts, submit enrollments, and retrieve files. Your company can have multiple Authorized Users.

Step 2) Current contacts will **not** automatically carry-over to the new CEP Customer Portal. Please tell LIMRA who all Authorized Users will be for the CEP Customer Portal with [this form](#). Prior to going "live", we'll send an email to all these users asking them to complete an online registration form.

New IDs File

In preparation for implementing CEP, LIMRA found that most companies don't retrieve the New IDs file. Therefore, LIMRA will no longer create the New IDs file as of April 22, 2019—unless your company has provided express instructions to continue doing so.
